Highlights from the 2025 AFFS Championships

The Australian Free Flight Society's 2025 Championship brought together the nation's most skilled aeromodellers and some internationals for a spectacular showcase of precision, endurance, and passion for flight. Spanning multiple events across F1 classes, vintage designs, and open categories, competitors gathered under perfect skies to test their aircraft and flying mettle.

Widgiewa Cup

F1A Glider saw a commanding performance from Albert Fathers, who clinched victory with a perfect 960 and a fly-off time of 202 seconds, narrowly edging out Ian Haigh (960 + 184). Malcolm Campbell rounded out the podium with a total of 180.

F1B Wakefield Rubber featured a tightly packed leaderboard, with three maxed-out flyers. Richard Blackam emerged victorious after a tremendous 397-second fly-off. Vin Morgan and Dave Ackery from NZ followed closely with 960 and 959 points, respectively.

F1C Power had no shortage of talent, as Andrew Linwood led the field with a 960 + 369. Veteran Roy Summersby and newcomer Murray Wilson trailed closely, demonstrating the consistency of Australia's power flyers. Warren Leadbeatter made the flyoff for his first time in a World Cup Event and finished 4th place after a nervous launch.

AFFS Cup

In the AFFS Cup, Richard Blackam again topped F1B with another perfect 960 and an incredible 413-second fly-off. In F1A, Malcolm Campbell surprised himself to win with 950. Roy Summersby dominated F1C with a flawless score of 960, cementing his status as one of the most reliable competitors in the discipline. 2nd place was Yuan Gao from China and Warren Leadbeatter had his first ever Podium in a World Cup event with 3rd place.

Southern Cross Cup

The Southern Cross Cup saw new leaders emerge. Bruce Hao captured F1B with a perfect 960, while Yuan Gao claimed F1C after a spectacular 319-second fly-off against Roy & Murray. Albert Fathers continued his form in F1A with another victory, securing his place as the dominant glider pilot of the series.

Combined Vintage & Mini Events

In the Combined Vintage class, Peter Scott piloted his 1956 Dream Weaver to victory with 512 points. Ian Haigh was 2nd with his 1941 Rubber Model and Warren Leadbeatter was 3rd with his 1953 Stomper. The Combined Mini category went to Roy Summersby with 600 + 259 in fly-offs, showcasing his range across multiple disciplines.

Open Classes – Combined %, Open Power, E36 and Classic Rubber

The Combined % Open class had Roy Summersby at the top once again in F1J, scoring 300 + 264, followed closely by Dave Shackelford and Terry Bond. In P-30, Vin Morgan led the field with a clean 360, while Michael Towell triumphed in E-36, matching that perfect score and edging out Natalie, Malcolm and Warren in the fly-off.

Open Rubber and Open Power both featured top-flight efforts, with Towell and Summersby winning their respective categories. Summersby's 540 + 223 in Open Power underscored a season of remarkable performances. Warren's overpowered Dixielander did some excellent aerobatics and just missed the ground several times. Ray Harvey's Dixie performed extremely well earning him 2nd Place in Open Power.

CL & HL Glider and Power Scramble

In Catapult Glider, Len Surtees soared to 180 points from his best three launches. Ian Haigh was 2nd yet again while Kathy Burford beat the rest of the boys to claim 3rd place. Len also won Hand Launched Glider with 1 max while Tahn Stowe clinched 2nd with 62, while Michael Towell dominated the Scramble event with an unmatched 1,576 points. Ian Haigh was 2nd with 1070 and Tahn Stowe 3rd with 1033 from a field of 8 competitors.

Final Thoughts

The Champion of Champions Trophy deservedly went to Roy Summersby with four 1st places and two 2nd places from a total of 8 events entered. His main rival was Ian Haigh with an incredible nine 2nd places from 10 events entered. Followed by Vin Morgan in 3rd place.

The 2025 AFFS Championship highlighted the strength and depth of Australia’s free flight community. Veterans and newcomers alike delivered exceptional performances across every discipline, and the camaraderie and sportsmanship on display were second to none.

Congratulations to all competitors and organizers for making the event a resounding success. Here’s to clear skies and even greater heights in 2026! See detailed report and photos in FFDU coming soon!
