EDITORIAL NOVEMBER 2023

Hi all, Santa is almost on his way. I hope there will be something under the tree for you on 25 December. However, before then there is a lot of 'doins' to be done. We have the 73rd National Championships to conduct 28 Dec – 4 Jan 2024, two Christmas parties at Richmond, and a contest or two and the odd Friday fly for fun. We start almost fresh in January 2024.

Some notes on the Nationals; Entries are due on 16 November, late entry fee after that. A couple of days grace may be acceptable but don't push your luck. Camping is available and the contact is Roy Summersby; email roydi123@optusnet.com.au or mob 0413 588 720. That is a lot more flexible than the entries. We have more than enough room for caravans and campers. Power and water are available and there are facilities for ladies and gents' showers. I was unavailable for the month of October and I am catching up.

In past meetings it was suggested that we purchase or build extra accommodation at West Wyalong on the AB Field to house extra guests during contests and possibly farm stays. This would take the form of one, two or three bed units. These could be transportable units or built on site with the same characteristics. We appear to have adequate infrastructure in waste disposal and electricity. Approval from the local council may or may not be required as the units will ostensibly, be removeable. It's about time we discussed this a bit more and pushed it up for more study.

The NSWFFS is in a unique situation. It owns its own 700 acre flying field capable of hosting many events at once and has accommodation for major and minor competitions. The NSWFFS is currently a member of the MAAA and full membership cost is \$120 per annum. The MAAA contribution is \$90 and the associate membership is \$30 per annum. It's about time we looked outside of the box and discussed other forms of membership to increase our visibility and ability to attract more members and flyers. Associate members have previously been called Friends of West Wyalong (FoWW). If a person does not fly model aircraft and has no interest in flying but has an interest in joining the FFS for other reasons there should be no impediment to joining. I am not sure that this has been previously understood. We may need to change our house rules, just something for thought.

The AB Field is fully owned by the NSWFFS and therefore the rules pertaining to having visitors and flyers to our field can be much more flexible. There are other organizations, clubs and flyers out there that we can attract to increase our membership and provide a flying site of excellence. We will soon host a group of glider flyers. The flyers are from different states and different clubs within the MAAA and need a field with sufficient height clearance and room to fly over. The AB Field ticks all the boxes. I have been approached by the president of AMAS, an organization of flyers who were previously members of the MAAA to visit and possibly fly on our field. Why would we exclude other flyers? This should be discussed by our members for resolution in June when new affiliations are due.

The MAAA has been around for the last 60 plus years or so. I can mention some of our members who have been loyal the whole time; Roy S, 60 plus years Tahn S, 60 plus as well, me 60 years but on and off, there are many others. There is a new breed of modeler around now. They could be described as the 'Newbies' with less than 10 years of membership and less years of service to the organization. Many want change and believe it or not change is inevitable. Some of their ideas are excellent but others not so. Change will also affect the NSWFFS and we should be prepared. Next AGM I intend to stand down. After 13 or 14 years as president this society needs some more innovative ideas and a president with a more progressive, aggressive and entrepreneurial outlook. Perhaps the same can be said for the secretary as well. Should we have defined terms?

A rewrite of the SOR is in the wind as well. A few years ago, a corporate legal firm in Melbourne (Lander & Rogers, Lawyers) was tasked to rewrite the current Statement of Rules. It significantly changes the way the executive is elected and brings the SOR into the modern era. I would hope that this is released for discussion soon. There has also been a change in the level of transparency within the executive of the MAAA and minutes of council and executive meetings are now available on the MAAA page. The minutes appear under Council Reports in the drop-down menu under 'About'. Annual reports are available in the same dropdown menu.

There are a number of other items I will ultimately talk to you about and seek consensus. I have mentioned change in this editorial, and change is coming. We will all need to have our thinking caps on!

He has been pushed out of the top spot by one of the world's best F1B flyers Stepan Stefanchuk, from Ukraine. There are two comps to go but as they are in Israel. I would doubt if they will be held. Well done, Bruce, Congratulations. It is very difficult for Australians to get a place in the world cup as Europe has so many competitions that one can attend without the huge travel distance that we have. As you can see Stepan flew in, and received points in 11 Comps. Bruces flew 7 comps for his points.

46TH Australian Free Flight Society Championships and Widgiewa Cup Narrandera & West Wyalong 2024



General Notes

- 1) Smoking on the field is not allowed. If you smoke in a car the doors must be closed.
- 2) Daily compulsory event briefings will be held before commencement of competition flying.
- 3A) Motorised retrieval, Narrandera flying site location (car, motorcycle, or electric bicycle) is allowed pending strict adherence to local mapped locations determined by the AFFS. Maps of determined Go/No locations will be provided. Strict adherence to the CDs daily decisions regarding motorised retrieval must be adhered to.
- 3B) Motorised retrieval, West Wyalong flying site location is allowed (car, motorcycle, electric bicycle) Any additional instructions from the NSWFFS must be adhered to.
- 4) Combined F1G, F1H & F1J First round will be "High Time" NOTE (6 min max first round only. NB time above 2 min max will only be used to resolve ties)
- 5) F1A, F1B & F1C First round max will be 4 minutes. (Weather permitting)
- 6) Flyoffs for F1A, F1B & F1C will be 10-minute duration.
- 7) FAI events will be flown from a flight line in 5 x 1-hour rounds, please assist by volunteering to time keep other competitors (**AFFS does not provide dedicated timekeepers**)
- 8) Gliders otherwise conforming to the F1H/A1 rules will be allowed in F1H at any weight provided they are fitted with a non-latchable towhook.
- 9) Old style F1J/Class 1 Power models – restricted to plain bearing motors of less than 1cc and no moving surfaces except DT will be allowed an 8 second motor run in F1J (bring out your Mini Weavers and ½A Vikings).
- 10) COMBINED VINTAGE, first flight will be "High Time" & must be launched before 0830 (6 min max first round only, NB time above 3 min max will only be used to resolve ties) Entry in more than 1 class allowed however only 1 (best) score to count for AFFS Champion. Note that the vintage cut-off date is 1956. Vintage classes get bonus points (2 per year pre-1956) as per MAAA rules 2009.
- 11) Open Power & Open Rubber, first flight will be "High Time" & must be launched before 0830 (6 min max first round only, NB time above 3 min max will only be used to resolve ties)
- 12) COMBINED % is 3 flights no rounds. FAI models are excluded from entry in combined %, Score is the percentage of the max for that class. HLG and CLG are allowed but are only allowed 3 flights (i.e., no discards) Two attempts are permitted for each flight (a 20 second attempt rule applies).
- 13) HLG/DLG are combined into one event. Only 1 set of scores allowed per competitor, all flights from the box marked by 4 cones.
- 14) Radio Dethermalization (RDT) is allowed in all events.
- 15) All Competitors must be in possession of a current MAAA/FAI Licence.
- 16) PLACEGETTERS models, lines, motors etc may be processed. There will be spot checks and check timekeeping on the field.
