ANNUAL REPORT TO THE NEW SOUTH WALES FREE FLIGHT SOCIETY - SEPTEMBER 2023

Hi Team, another year in the saddle and still a way to go. A little bit of turmoil this year with the remnants of Covid but I am happy to report we do not appear to have lost anybody else to that pandemic. A few members have maxed out but all have had decent flight times.

The program and the entry form for the 73rd national championships are out and I am expecting entries to start rolling in. We have a PayPal facility now and that might be a bit easier for some of our modelers. Our registrar for the Nationals is Paul Turner. Paul is primarily a control line flyer of many years and now a not quite computer expert. Be patient please unless of course you would like to take his position.

I am absolutely delighted to report that the Australian F1B team managed a third-place team podium finish at the recent world championships. Our full team of A, B, C flyers managed sixth out of 40 countries attending. The NSWFFS members were Bruce Hao, Gary Pope, Roy Summersby, Andrew Linwood, and Matt Hannaford, with Gary Goodwin manager. That is a fantastic result. If you get a chance and have not already done so have a look at our Facebook page, there are some great photos. However, no rest for the wicked! Qualification for the next world champs starts on 1 December this year.

I must thank the committee for their work this year, it has been busy and challenging. I had hoped to have a rest this year but there is still work to be done for the Nationals and the FFS. I will stay another year if I remain unchallenged. I don't think this report can express enough thanks to the members of the committee and members of the FFS who really hold this association together. It certainly is a dedicated group and I am happy to be part of it. A special welcome to Sam Kirby, our new registrar.

The existing committee has offered to remain in place and there are no current challenges to existing positions. Elections will take place at the AGM on 15 September.

Relationships with the MAAA executive, the council and the FFS are somewhat strained at the moment. The executive and ANSW claim that they have three votes at council meetings and this appears to be in direct contrast to the Statement of Rules. There are no recorded minutes or amendments to the SOR. The rule is that all states receive equal representation at council and annual meetings, this is a significant dispute. It is such a pity that dealings with the executive and the council have become adversarial instead of cooperative.

At a zoom meeting in July the FFS moved motions of no confidence in the president and the vice president. Unfortunately, both motions failed but it must have been sufficient notice for the president to realize his continued service. He announced at that meeting that he would not serve past the annual meeting in May 2024. There are also outstanding allegations into bullying and sexual harassment which have been made without investigation. This is obviously of some concern to the executive because legal representation has been hired by the executive. An initial non budgeted estimate of \$2500 and appears open-ended.

The saga continues with the executive attempting to take over the job of the safety manager. The safety manager has an excellent working relationship with CASA and understands the new and complicated rules and costs imposed by CASA. I believe the same does not apply to the executive.

On a happier note, the Friday Flyers email distribution is working well and we now regularly get a good attendance each Friday. Often these flying days degenerate into talking fests and tea drinking contests. Jacko's jam dots are a specialty and enjoyed by most or the first to get one. Our parking fees are growing and I only need more suggestions about presents for Pauline's and Linda's kids. I have some foamy gliders and a couple of easy to assemble rubber model kits. I know it would be nice to continue on the aero theme so how about some more ideas. I will ask the ladies how old the kids are and let you know.

Our contest calendar will be published in draft shortly. I would ask that every member have look at it and make suggestions. Too often I hear that a certain day or event could be made better if it were held on another day or in a different location. Please do not be bashful about making a suggestion. The draft will include volunteers to CD each contest day. If you cannot make it say so early so we can appoint another.

Well, here we are, at the end of another reporting and election period. I would hope that all these issues can be resolved before the next annual meeting. The MAAA has been around for a long time and it would be a shame to see another division similar to the AMAS departure. The troops are restless, let's hope for peace.

Future of the MAAA

Open letter to the current executive of the MAAA.

Having been an affiliate member of the MAAA for more than 60 years, and having served on the MAAA council both as a VP for 12 months and as the NSWFFS delegate for more than 20 years, I find the actions and inactions of the current executive to be at odds with the core aims and ideals of the organisation.

Apparently the federal voting system, which has successfully underpinned the MAAA since its inception, has now been subverted, whereby one state has more votes than any other state or territory. I must have missed the vote required to alter the constitution to allow this change, or it has been carried out by "sleight of hand".

Neil Tank the former long serving President, quoted as one of his main achievements whilst in office, the re-establishment of the MAAA Wingspan magazine. Providing a professional way of communicating with affiliate members and showcasing aeromodelling to the general public.

Under the current executive, Wingspan is no longer provided.

With the two issues of aging demographic and declining membership setting a trajectory that will see the organisation defunct by 2040, what strategies, programs and processes is the current executive putting in place to prevent this outcome?

Former executives of the MAAA lobbied various governments for decades, to be recognised as a "Sport". Now that battle has been won, and pathways opened for funding under various sports authorities, why has the current executive abandoned its National Championships which have been run for more than 80 years?

Most successful sporting bodies run programs in schools. These programs actively foster and promote participation thereby guaranteeing the growth and continuation of the sport as well as maintaining a public presence. What programs are the current executive proposing or putting in place to ensure continued participation in our wonderful sport?


