Nicknamed 'Gentleman Jim' had a very long love for the building and flying rubber powered model aircraft.

He was a continuous member of the NSWFFS for the last 38 plus years and flew at Richmond on most Fridays.

Gentleman Jim' he flew all the rubber classes, with his favorite being a class called Coupe d'hiver. This is an international class and is also known as F1G. Jim was very good at this class and was a very hard man to beat. His models initially looked a bit agricultural but on close inspection he used the latest technology in construction and his propeller design was very very efficient.

He was a mentor to any who asked, and he helped whenever he could. In days gone by he was the Treasurer then Vice President to the NSWFFS. He was a feared parking money collector; nobody refused Jim's collection technique.

I am not sure Jim ever did anything wrong but occasionally he would leave lengths of wire on the field after he left for the day. These were sought after gems which were presented to a red-faced Jim the following Friday and were referred to as Jim wires. This became a standard joke and a reward for any finder.

One of our members visited Jim just a few weeks before he passed on, and Jim donated some of his modeling gear to the NSWFFS to raise funds for our own flying field at West Wyalong.

We thank you and miss you Jim.




