EDITORIAL NOVEMBER 2022

Hi Team, if you did not already know our registrar and good friend Barry Lee died in Fairfield hospital about two weeks ago. Prior to our scale contest at West Wyalong I had been trying to email Barry without reply and that was unusual. I found out from his daughter Jess, visiting from Queensland, that Barry had had a fall, contracted an infection and had been admitted for treatment. Barry's wife Margaret was also in the same hospital in the next bed. I managed to visit Barry as did a number of his friends. I did not realize how poor his condition was.

Barry was our registrar for many years and was a very quiet operator. His history in aeromodelling commenced in 1950 when he built a rubber powered 'Wirraway' which unfortunately never flew. His interest increased in 1951 when he met Ivor F and his interest never waned. He flew many different models including free flight, control line and radio control.

In the sixties Barry became the secretary of the Southern Cross model Club, ultimately becoming the whole committee, and started the Free flight Down Under with Alan Edwards. He served in many voluntary positions on the NSWAA then the NSWFFS.

Thanks to those who visited Barry while he was in hospital, especially John Corby who arrived only hours after Barry's death and spoke to Barry's wife Margaret.
