Annual Report to the New South Wales Free Flight Society September 2022

Hi Team, another year has passed and ever so quickly. It could be that we are so much busier these days and do not have as much spare time. As usual we will need to provide an annual treasurers report plus other items for you to peruse and review the years activities.

I must first thank the members of the committee for the work they have done this year with a brief description of some of the things they have managed. The only person who has not completely pulled his weight is me, so I am the only slacker. Our VP, Aaron has done some great work on publicity and managed the president's job in my absence. Our secretary Roy Summersby is a constant. His work raising funds on eBay, the shop management, and his administration tasks are second to none. Gary Goodwin is our treasurer and keeps us well and truly accounted. Goody also managed to make a few dollars bringing in Redfin engines for small models

Barry Lee has been our registrar and web page manager for too many years to remember and works quietly and efficiently behind the scenes. Warren Leadbetter has recently taken over the web page management and constantly updates our Facebook page. Michael Towell our safety officer brings me up to date with recent safety changes and is in regular contact with other groups. Phil Warren keeps us honest with scale competitions and when Covid is not about manages our scale Trans-Tasman. Peter Scott manages contests at Richmond and keeps us up to date with SAMs. John Pennells is our librarian and has revamped our library and maintains the index and quality of the material.

At this stage I have no resignations and the committee will be reelected at the AGM after the general meeting is complete.

A special thanks to those gentlemen but also to the many others who have the enthusiasm and ability to help on working bees and with contest arrangements.

We will soon have a new membership system, the old one is sadly running out of computer support. The new system will be staged in over the next year with appropriate instructions and possibly lessons. Barry Lee our current registrar will manage this system until it is up and running then hand over to a new registrar. I have no record of Barry's service except that it is somewhere between 30 and 50 years as registrar.

Friday and Sunday competition flying has been interrupted by Covid, the flu and wet weather. There has been two significant floods at our Richmond field which has severely damaged the turf and the two roads, Bensons and Onus leading to the property are badly rutted and soft in sections. I hope that the council can repair the roads and the river banks before the next major downfalls which are thought to arrive in February next year.

Aaron and his father designed and built a stand for the radial engine donated by Robert Walker from Whispering Pines Organics and attached a plaque. The radial now stands in front of the camp kitchen for all to see some early real flying history.

Our field at West Wyalong is in good condition and the areas mown have turned out t be excellent flying sites. Unfortunately, at the last report, 8 September the road leading into the field is deteriorating due

to excessive rain. Roadworks are on our program but rain has prevented the movement of heavy machinery on the property.

Plans for the future include; a mixed scale weekend for RC, CL and FF November 2022, Christmas gathering 28 Dec-2 Jan, mini champs 2023, our state and Vic state champs and a WW national championship 2023-24. More news on these later.

2022 has been a busy year. Covid, the flu, the passing of some of our older modelers. I hope that 2023 will be better, more profitable and a little dryer.

As stated, the weather was perfect for all types of flying and it was certainly made use of by many. The control line circles were buzzing, Sport type radio models were slowly pushing there way into the blue and there was always some sport free flight going on in the paddock on the northern side. I tried to wear out my SE5a with many flights, I even had a go with the Lavochkin but this put me in trouble with the management, as the model is electric which is taboo till 1.00pm on Sunday. The free flight field changed to the southern side on the Sunday as the sheep were starting to lamb so we left them to it.

The control line model of the meet was the Peacemaker and there were many, (see photos) most powered by 2.5 diesels followed by the glows. As I have only flown Good Year racers for the last few years it took quite a few flights to get back to throwing a model around the sky like I should have been able to. They are a great model for this type of rally event (no competition). Radio models seemed to be a mixed bunch from tomboys to the Keil Kraft Southerner which again was the radio/free flight model of the meet. Free flight was a huge range of sport models along with quite a number of scale or semi scale models including biplanes and twin powered jobs. Everyone was having fun which is what the weekend is all about.


As normal the Cowra club had available hot breakfast, lunch and coffee available. They are to be congratulated on putting on a great weekend.
